Luna Community College status changed from “Accredited – Probation” to “Accredited” Effective: February 29, 2024

The Higher Learning Commission has removed the sanction of Probation for Luna Community College in Las Vegas, New Mexico.

HLC took this action based on the institution’s ability to demonstrate that it is in compliance with HLC requirements. It was placed on Probation in November 2021, when it was determined to be out of compliance with HLC requirements.
